

The incorrect arrangement of suction roller seals represents one of the primary causes of energy wasting and profit losses due to downtimes. Tests of an American manufacturer have shown that drive power consumption can vary by up to 100 A, depending on the sealing set. That difference adds up to an annual loss of 17,000 \in to 44,000 \in per roller.

The precise arrangement of the seals depends on the suction roller manufacturer s specs and on the field of application. The most economic operation of suction rollers is achieved by way of the individual adaptation of the seal to the roller. A number of manufacturers and suppliers offer such services and *Wefapress* ranks among these providers.
